

## M&S Objectives

*Masculinities and Society* is an interuniversity, interdisciplinary and partnering team research. Its objectives are twofold:

- 1) To better understand four realities faced by men (fatherhood, violence, health and cultural diversity) described as priority issues by authors interested in the development of men and masculinities research.
- 2) To better understand the connection between realities faced by men and social practices, in particular through better knowledge of requests made by men for help and the response of health and social services.

The partnership between the researchers, students and community partners will result in a research agenda that will contribute considerably to the development of knowledge and practices in health and social departments on the issue of realities faced by men. This will be achieved in part through training activities and the transfer and dissemination of knowledge.

Finally, this agenda has a liberal profeminist perspective (Clatterbaugh, 1997) in support of claims and advances associated with feminist research and the women's movement.

## History

Since the 1980s, research on realities faced by men has expanded considerably, with studies focusing more particularly on analyses considering the gender dimension. This has led to an examination of realities deemed problematic (father disengagement, health neglect and violence, but especially violence against women) from a standpoint of male socialization. As violence by men against women is still a major field of research, new issues of concern are coming to the forefront.

It is in this context that the Masculinities and Society team emerged from the CRI-VIFF to be subsidized by the Fonds québécois de la recherche sur la société et la culture (FQRSC) under the aegis of the *Programme Soutien aux équipes de recherche – Équipe en centre* from 2007 until 2011.
